Emergency First Aid Procedures

Eyes: Flush with plenty of water for 15 minutes. Remove contact lenses if worn, flush after 5 minutes. Get medical attention.

Skin: Flush and wash with water. Remove and wash contaminated clothing. Get medical attention if irritation persists

Ingestion: Drink 2 glasses (16 oz.) of water. Get medical attention. Do not induce vomiting.

SECTION VII: Precautions for Safe Handling and Use

Handling and Storage: Keep out of reach of children.

Release or Spill: Small: Dispose in approved sewage. Large: Dike and contain. Do not let into drains/bodies of water.

Waste Disposal: Dispose of in accordance to local, state and federal regulations.
