

## SECTION VI: Health Hazard Data/First Aid Procedures

### Signs and Symptoms of Exposure

### Emergency First Aid Procedures

**Inhalation:** Move victim to fresh air. Give artificial respiration if victim is not breathing. Get medical attention.

**Eyes:** Flush with plenty of water for 10 minutes.

**Skin:** Flush and wash with water. Remove and wash contaminated clothing.

**Ingestion:** Drink 2 glasses (16 oz.) of water. Induce vomiting. Get medical attention. Never give anything to an unconscious person.

**Handling and Storage:** Keep out of reach of children.

**Release or Spill:** Dike and contain small discharges. For larger spills, recover with pump or vac, or use absorbent material. Do not flush into sewer, stream or other bodies of water.
