Medical Conditions Generally Aggravated by Exposure: Existing dermatitis

Emergency First Aid Procedures

Inhalation: Remove to fresh air. Give artificial respiration if not breathing. Get medical attention.

Eyes: Flush with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

Skin: Flush and wash with warm water. Remove contaminated clothing.

Ingestion: Drink 2 glasses (16 oz.) of water. Seek medical attention.
